# Catskill Mountain Railroad's spring rides return

KINGSTON, N.Y. >> Catskill Mountain Railroad's Spring Flyer trains return to the historic Ulster and Delaware Railroad corridor starting Saturday, April 6.

The railroad coaches allow patrons to enjoy the scenery from their unique perspective, or aboard an open-air flat car, a news release said.

The train will cross Esopus Creek, pass through the Hurley Flats, some of the oldest farmlands in the country, and then climb up Hurley Mountain, the release said.

All trains are roundtrip departing from Westbrook Lane Station at Kingston Plaza near the Hannaford Supermarket.

Spring Flyer trains will operate every Saturday from April 6 through May 25. Trains depart at 11 a.m., 1 p.m. and 3 p.m. The round-trip lasts approximately 90 minutes.

Tickets are \$18 for adults, \$17 for seniors/military and veterans and \$12 for children. Children under 2 on lap ride free with an adult paid fare.
